Is Natural Gas the Next Wave or a Lost Opportunity?

ften the simplest solutions are the best solutions. I learned that lesson long ago when I was a crime reporter, and it has stood the test of time in fields far removed from the evil vicissitudes of human behavior. If you want to solve a crime, look for the simplest explanation of events, and you'll likely find your solution. And that might well be the reason I have been so enamored with natural gas as at least a partial solution to the multifaceted issue of the automobile and the environment, an issue complicated further still by geopolitics.

Back in 2006 in my book The Complete Idiot's Guide to Hybrid and Alternative Fuel Vehicles, I wrote that hybrids had become the darlings of the environmental-celebrity set. I also wrote that Midwestern farmers had embraced ethanol and other biofuels, but, my statement continued with, "natural gas, a fuel that some experts say is a neglected treasure, could well have equal or greater promise than both of the more highly publicized technologies in solving the issues of high fuel cost and environmental concerns." The reason for the enthusiasm back then was that natural gas represented a simple solution. Compared to gasoline, natural gas burns "very clean." According to the Department of Energy, when natural gas is used in an internal combustion engine, it offers 90 percent less carbon monoxide and 60 percent less nitrous oxides. Natural gas even offers advantages versus gasoline in the production of carbon dioxide, resulting in approximately 35 percent less production of the "greenhouse gas" when used to fuel an internal combustion engine. Beyond that, natural gas can be used in conventional piston engines with relatively few modifications, which gives its use a major cost advantage versus hybrid powerplants that necessitate the use of costly storage batteries.

In many ways, natural gas seems like the simple solution. Further, since 2006 there has been a revolution in the way natural gas is recovered. The use of hydraulic fracturing – "fracking" in the vernacular – has literally exploded (no pun intended) in the past half-dozen years, creating much larger reserves

of natural gas than many dreamed existed. The abundance of the newly found natural gas already has sent the price plunging, which is another reason to believe compressed natural gas (CNG) could have a strong future as a motor fuel.

If that is the case, why wasn't the recent Los Angeles Auto Show littered with all-new natural-gas-powered vehicles? Why isn't CNG being hailed as the fuel of the future?

There are several reasons why natural gas hasn't become the latest buzzword. One is the fact that the current regulatory environment is tilted in favor of hybrids and electrification. Many in the environmental community are opposed to any kind of combustion in automobiles, and that mindset has held sway with the regulators. (One has to wonder where they think most of our electricity comes from here in America, but that's another story). Another is the fact that some of those same environmentalists are as opposed to fracking as they are to the emission of carbon dioxide, if not more so. When I recently asked Volkswagen executives about expanding the use of natural gas in their vehicles, they responded with the widely held European view that fracking is environmentally unsound.

Yet another reason that natural gas seems to be facing an uphill battle is similar to the issue facing full electrification – namely infrastructure. If new cars are to use CNG, there would have to be thousands of outlets where consumers can buy it. The at-home fill-up strategy seems even less viable for CNG cars than it does for pure electrics.

So in this case, while we are almost floating on new reserves of natural gas, and while it does offer a reasonably simple solution to a multitude of woes, it seems natural gas is not ready for primetime as an automotive fuel... and it might never be.
