ven the devastation of Superstorm Sandy has not put a damper on the rosy predictions that the United States auto market has not only come back, but it also is poised for an even more robust future. While we at Kelley Blue Book happily acknowledge that the American market isn't in the absolutely desperate Depression-like state it was in in 2009, we don't think it is quite time to pull out the paper hats and noisemakers.

Yes, the seasonally adjusted annual sales rate (SAAR) did hit 14.9 million units in September, and yes, even with Sandy literally blowing out a potentially hot sales weekend in the Northeast, the sales rate in October still came in at well over 14 million. But that doesn't mean we are on the fast track to a 16-plus million unit SAAR in 2013 or even 2014. In other words, we are still a long way from what could be regarded as a full recovery in the U.S. auto sector. Certainly many signs are positive, but there are still storm clouds dotting the horizon that could affect the American car market.

First, we have the obvious signs of a full-on recession in Western Europe. Instead of biting the bullet and solving the debt crisis, various European governments have kicked the can down the road for more than a year as some European economies, like Greece, Italy and Spain, have crumbled before our eyes. Sadly the situation could get worse before it gets better, and now the European downturn has been accompanied by a downturn in China as well. With Europe and Asia sneezing, there is more than a chance that we in America will catch their cold.

At the same time, another storm cloud on the horizon is the looming "fiscal cliff," which is essentially a potential Sandy-like Superstorm of tax increases and deep government spending cuts that could kick in. Since the "fiscal cliff" scenario was created because the U.S. government couldn't get together to solve the budgetary issues earlier, one has to wonder if America will be able to solve the massive challenges this time around. The fiscal cliff is certainly no laughing matter. If what has already been enacted as law actually takes effect on January 1, the Congressional Budget Office has estimated that the combined result would mean a 4-percentage point cut in gross domestic product (GDP) next year, which would be more than enough to send America reeling into recession. It also predicts that unemployment, which is already too high to generate much positive movement in the economy, would go up nearly 1-percentage point. Bid a quick good-bye to a 14-million-unit SAAR.

So while it appears that happier days are on the way, and they might well be, we still have some stern challenges to face before we can rest easy knowing the U.S. economy is on the right track. Certainly we are not at the bottom of the Great Recession, but we haven't quite climbed out of the hole yet either.
