The latest version of the Honda Civic is proof that even if something isn't broken, it can still be fixed. More updated than fixed, actually, with a new look both inside and out, higher fuel efficiency and five different iterations to fit just about everyone.

#6: [2012 BMW 6 Series](#)

Yes, it now offers an adjustable suspension to better fulfill the luxo-sport promise of its grand tourer design. And yes, the passenger cabin is higher-style and higher-tech than before. But it's the new sheet metal – particularly the sleeker and sportier rear end – that solidifies for the new 6 series a spot on this list.
